THE SNAP! SPACE GALLERY PRESENTS STUNNING VISUAL ARTWORK.

The past few years, the Snap! Orlando photography festival brought some of the medium's biggest names to town each May. However, having recently acquired a permanent space on Colonial Drive, founder Patrick Kahn is focusing on the gallery and putting the festival on hold until 2015.

Visitors can still expect to see a variety of work by the world's best photographers, but some jewelry, sculpture and video installations also will be included in select shows. Kahn's ambitious schedule is a testament to his passion. Opening on May 2 is *Edge of a Dream*, a group photography exhibition curated by Patrick and Holly Kahn that features nationally celebrated artists, such as Thomas Dodd, Wendy Sacks, Richard Tuschman and Elise Bloom. Work includes figurative narratives, fantastical scenes and more, and all of the participating artists are scheduled to attend the opening.

Another group show, *Snap! Attacks*, opens on June 20. Curated by Snap! Orlando and online digital gallery Art Attacks, this exhibition will showcase internationally celebrated talents, including Andrew Spear, Mark Gmehling, Rebecca Rose and Ransom & Mitchell. **OR**
