EVENT PARKING INFORMATION

PARKING AND GETTING TO ARTS FOR ALL DAY:

Arts for ALL Day will be located at Loch Haven Park. The main check-in, children's area and exhibits will be located inside the Lowndes Shakespeare Center (812 E. Rollins Street).

There are approximately 500 free spaces located inside Loch Haven Park to be used on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is also limited free parking along Mills Avenue in front of Orlando Museum of Art (2416 N. Mills Avenue). We have worked with our neighbors and have secured free off-site parking as follows:

- Florida Hospital Garage (2328 Alden Road). The garage will be open and free all day. Loch Haven Park is a short walk down either Princeton or Rollins Streets. Also on Alden Road, you may utilize the surface lot of McCree Construction (2100 Alden Road).
- McGruder Eye Institute (1911 Mills Avenue) and Florida Urology (1812 Mills Avenue) will have their surface lots open and available to park at no charge. It is a short walk up Mills to Loch Haven Park or you may cross the Urban Trail foot bridge and be on the grounds of Mennello Museum of American Art (900 E. Princeton Street) in just minutes.
