Douglas Kirkland: A Life in Pictures

SNAP! Orlando presents the legendary photographer and his timeless work in honor of the gallery's 10th anniversary.

SNAP! ORLANDO BRINGS BACK LEGENDARY Hollywood photographer Douglas Kirkland for a series of events, including an exhibition, artist talk, and dinner and book signing at its SNAP! Space gallery. Kirkland has been at the cutting edge of fashion, photojournalism and portraiture, working for the world's most reputable magazines. As a young photographer in 1961 he was assigned to photograph Marilyn Monroe and during several hours in a closed studio one night, captured a stunning portfolio of alluring and intimate images that survive to this day as a testament to her beauty and vulnerability.

"We are delighted to bring Douglas back to Orlando on the occasion of SNAP! Orlando's 10-year anniversary," says Patrick Kahn, the gallery's cofounder. "This legendary photographer was our first headliner after graciously accepting our invitation to be the featured artist at the inaugural exhibition and series of events that opened SNAP! Orlando a decade ago. It is an honor to have both Douglas and his wife Françoise with us again."

The exhibition presents a comprehensive retrospective of the now 85-year-old's iconic images taken over the past 60 years. One of today's best known

long-term photographers, Kirkland worked for *Look* and *Life* magazines where he photographed such celebrity icons as Elizabeth Taylor, Marilyn Monroe, Marlene Dietrich, Audrey Hepburn, Jack Nicholson, Mick Jagger, Coco Chanel, Brigitte Bardot, John Lennon, Andy Warhol, Charlie Chaplin and Grace Jones, among countless others.

Exhibition co-curators Kahn and his wife Holly knew Kirkland for years before they moved from Los Angeles to Orlando and formed the contemporary art organization SNAP! Orlando.

“We could not think of a better way to thank Douglas and Françoise for the trust they put in us 10 years ago, than to invite them back as guests of honor, along with a remarkable display of their legacy, on the occasion of the gallery’s anniversary,” says Kahn. **OAM**
