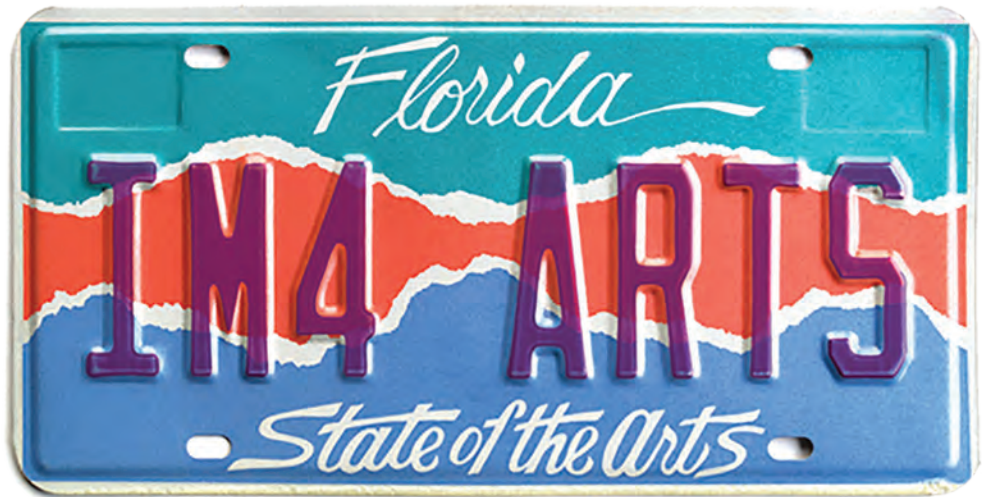


Many Ways to Support the Arts

There are many ways to support arts and culture in our community. Making a gift to the **United Arts - Arts for ALL Fund** is the quickest way to support a large number (more than 60) of varied and diverse arts and cultural organizations. When you donate to the arts, you ensure the community has high-quality arts and cultural productions, our youth have access to vital arts education programming, and Central Florida has a more vibrant standard of living. Below are some ideas for additional ways you can show your support every day:

1. **AmazonSmile** — Is Amazon your go-to site for online purchases? Do you have a birthday or anniversary gift to buy? Are you looking to treat yourself? When you shop on smile.amazon.com, the AmazonSmile Foundation will donate 0.5% of any item you purchase marked “Eligible for AmazonSmile donation” to the charitable organization of your choice. It just takes a moment to enter the nonprofit designation such as “United Arts of Central Florida, Inc.,” and all items are the same price as regular Amazon. 2. **State of the Arts License Plate** — When you select the State of the Arts license plate for your car, a portion of your tag renewal fee supports the Local Arts Agency in your county. United Arts of Central Florida is proud to be the designated Local Arts Agency for Orange County. When your auto registration comes up for renewal, please consider the State of the Arts plate. Contact your local Department of Motor Vehicles for more information.
3. **Event Sponsor** — Is your company looking to get their name out in the community? United Arts of Central Florida puts on several events each year, including the annual board meeting, the *Collaborative Campaign for the Arts* Kickoff Reception, Orange and Osceola County Public Schools Principals Arts Appreciation Breakfasts and the new *Empower the Arts Campaign* Kickoff Reception. Audiences for these events range in the hundreds and include the



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- area’s most generous donors, community leaders and partners, elected officials and school administrators. Sponsorships start at just \$1,000 and include benefits such as logo placement on event materials, recognition on United Arts’ website and in the annual report, VIP seating, recognition in press releases, the opportunity to promote your company at the event and more.
4. **Workplace Giving Campaign** — Holding a United Arts workplace campaign engages your employees by raising awareness for the varied and diverse arts and cultural programming available to them while they come together as a team to support their community. Setup is easy, and payroll deduction options are available.

One of the best ways you can support our area’s cultural providers is by buying a ticket and attending a performance, exhibition, class or event. Many free events are also listed. Sign up on the site for a weekly newsletter, with highlights selected from the spectrum of choices available each week.
